









Itinerary - Saturday, June 24, 2023

- 9am-12pm Rehearsal - after rehearsal load large instruments.
- 5:00pm Meet at LAUNCH FISHERS on Visionary Way
(STUDENTS MUST BE DROPED OFF AT MARSHALING YARD - see map #2 below)
- Student drivers may also park the **THE OLD MARSH** Allisonville Rd. & 116th street (shuttle begins at 3:00pm)
- Parents can pick up at **THE OLD MARSH** Allisonville Rd. & 116th street, however have to be in the lot by 6pm
- 5:00pm Parade Line-up begins
- 6:00pm Parade Begins (we are in unit 19)
- ~7:00pm **CHANGE!** Parade ends - at **THE OLD MARSH**
- 7:30pm Meet back at school to unload truck (tubas and percussion ONLY)

-  WEAR YOUR **RED** PARADE SHIRT (will distribute Friday 6/23 at rehearsal) and dark comfortable, appropriate length shorts)
-  Portable restrooms will be available for parade participants at the Marshaling Yard
-  Leave your instrument case in your car! **DO NOT** bring the case to the Marshaling Yard. You can't march and play AND carry your case
-  Bring snack/ water (no water jugs) rather a recyclable bottle. This will be consumed before the parade
-  REMINDER - BRING SUNGLASSES/ SUNSCREEN/ DRINK WATER BEFORE YOU ARRIVE
-  WE WILL BE PASSING OUT WATER DURING THE PARADE AS WELL! These will be from sterilized Sport bottles which will NOT be held by the students rather will be squirted by one of our chaperones - Absolutely NO part of the bottle will touch the students!

MAP #1




STUDENTS MAY BE DROPPED OFF BY LAUNCH FISHERS BY 415PM

IF STUDENTS DRIVE THEY NEED TO PARK BY THE OLD MARCH ON 116TH AND ALLISONVILLE THEN TAKE THE SHUTTLE TO THE MARSHALING YARD. SHUTTLES STOP AT 430!!!!

Inclement Weather Protocols

- Follow Spark!Fishers on social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) for up-to-date announcements about the event.
- Spark!Fishers is a rain or shine event. However, if there is a torrential downpour (constant), ongoing thunderstorms with lightning present or other inclement weather, activities may be postponed or canceled.
- If lightning at any time is located within half hour proximity of event, attendees will be sent to their vehicles, or to a nearby building or nearby parking garage for cover until conditions are deemed safe.
- If inclement weather, event will be canceled. We will make every effort to postpone if possible before canceling.
- Decision to be made by 3pm for Parade, 8pm for Fireworks.
